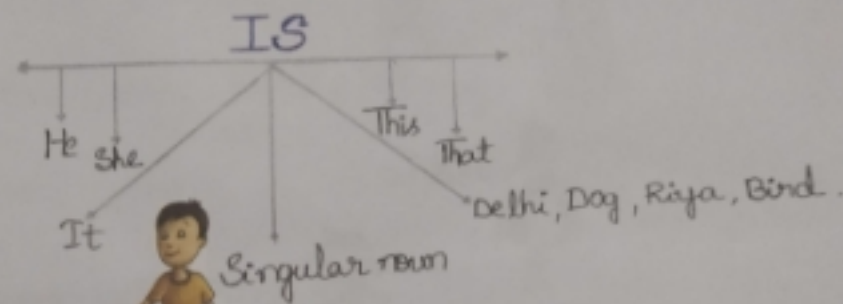

Use of Is, Am and Are

- * Use of is:
- * Is is always used for a single person, place or a thing.
- * We use 'is' with singular nouns and pronouns.



- * He is a boy. 
- * She is dancing. 
- * It is a table. 
- * This is a cat. 
- * That is a chair. 
- * Riya is a good girl. 
- * The bird is flying. 

* Use of Am :

* We use "am" only with I.

AM → I

* I am a boy.



* I am playing.



* I am very happy today.



* I am going to market



* I am singing.



* I am girl.





Use of Are :


Are - [Plural]
