

# Singular and Plural

Singular means only one.  
Plural means more than one.

Here some rules are there to convert singular into plural form.

Rule - 1 :-

Add 'S' at the end of a singular noun to make it plural.

S + P

CUP + CUPS  
Plate + Plates  
Tray + Trays  
Mug + Mugs  
Tree + Trees  
Plant + Plants  
Flower + Flowers  
Key + Keys



Shirt + Shirts  
 Van + Vans  
 Apple + Apples

### Rule - 2 :-

Singular nouns ending  
 in 's', ss, ch, sh, x, o,  
 or z need an 'es' at the  
 end to become plural.

s + p

Box + Boxes  
 Fox + Foxes  
 Tax + Taxes  
 Dish + Dishes  
 Brush + Brushes  
 Glass + Glasses  
 Church + Churches  
 Class + Classes  
 Bus + Buses  
 Watch + Watches  
 Mango + Mangoes  
 Potato + Potatoes  
 Branch + Branches
