Three degrees of the adjectives

1.The positive degree

2.The comparative degree.

3 . The superlative degree.

Usually the comparative degree is formed by the addition of "er" to the positive degree form.

E.g: tall— taller

Short—shorter

Near—nearer.

The superlative degree is usually formed by the addition of 'est'.

ex: strong stronger strongest.

Broad broader boardest.

Near nearer nearest.
